

Children's Online Privacy Protection Act

We recognize that protecting children's identities and privacy on-line is important and that the responsibility to do so rests with both the on-line industry and with parents. The Credit Union does not knowingly solicit or collect data from children and as per the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA), the Credit Union does not knowingly market to children under the age of 13 online or otherwise.

If an employee receives information from anyone who identifies himself/herself as being under the age of 13 or if an employee has reason to believe someone under the age of 13 is making the contact, that contact will be treated accordingly. Occasionally the Credit Union may promote children's products or events, such as coloring contests. In these circumstances, we may collect information in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.
